




# Lenten Bible Study

Come on out and join us for some fun! We'll be playing every Thursday night at 7:30 pm in the church sanctuary. We will not be playing on March 28th.



Maundy Thursday is an alternate name for Holy Thursday. The English word "Maundy" comes from the Latin *mandatum*, which means "commandment."

As recorded in John's gospel, on his last night before his betrayal and arrest, Jesus washed the feet of his disciples and then gave them a new commandment to love one another as he had loved them (John 13:34).

While John's gospel does not record the institution of the Lord's Supper among the events of this night, the other gospels do. This is why Christians have traditionally celebrated Holy communion on this night. Please join us on March 28 for our service at 7:00.
