Here are a few things that the Trustees have been working on in the past few months:

1 - Sponsored and worked at the All-Church Work Day onApril 1st. Thank you to everyone who came to help!2 - Checked sprinklers and fixed a few of them.

3 - Had Myers Heating and Air come out . They serviced the church heaters and replaced two inducer motors and a heat exchanger.

4 - Worked with the Grand Island Little League to play games on our ball fields in May and June.

5 - Our former lawn serviceman, Kelly, retired last year. The Trustees obtained estimates from other companies and hired Premier Lawns to do the work. They started on April 19th.

6 - They also obtained estimates for a snow removal service.The new company that was hired is Spartan Snow Services.7 - A lift was brought in and the Trustees cleaned the ceiling fans in the sanctuary and adjusted the platform lights.

8 - They are working on a concrete pathway and pad where an engraved, cement bench will be placed in memory of Jerry
Brand. It will be in the Prayer Walk nearest to Independence.
9 - In the church parking lot, they had Gottlob Asphalt come on April 24th, to fill in the deep cracks in the asphalt.
10 - They helped move the two old desks out to the garage and bring the new ones in.

- * Go online to redcrossblood.org and click on Donate Blood.
- * Download the American Red Cross Blood Donor app and make an appointment on the app (see picture of app that you can search for)!

You must be at least 17-years-old, weigh at least 110 lbs. and be in generally good health. All donors will receive a \$10 e-gift card to a merchant of their choice.
